



Prelude, Announcements & Preparation




Call to Worship—Psalm 5:2-4, 7-8, 11-12


- Pastor: Give attention to the sound of my cry,

- All: Lead me, O LORD, in your righteousness because of my enemies; make your way straight before me.
- Pastor: Let all who take refuge in you rejoice; let them ever sing for joy,

and spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may exult in you.

Corporate Confession of Sin—based on I John 1:5-10

Pastor: Lord, we come confessing. We have heard your message and it has been proclaimed to us. You are light, and in You there is no darkness at all.

- All: If we say we have fellowship with you while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.
- Pastor: But if we walk in the light as You are in the light, we have fellowship with one another.

All: And the blood of Jesus Your Son cleanses us from all sin.

Pastor: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves.

- All: And the truth is not in us.
- Pastor: If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- All: If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

The Reading of the Word—Philippians I:3-II

Guidelines for the Lord's Supper

The Lord's Supper is the family meal for Christians. We invite all baptized Christians who are members of a congregation that proclaims the gospel, and who are at peace with God and with their neighbor, and who seek strength to live more faithfully for Christ to join us.

If you are not a Christian, or if you are not prepared to share in this meal, we encourage you to spend this time in prayer. You can find some sample prayers on the next page. We hope that this time is helpful to you as you consider your relationship with Jesus Christ and with His people, the church.


At Cornerstone, we come forward to receive communion. You may take the bread at the first table and then proceed to either side for the wine/grape juice.

Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. If what you claim is true, please guide me, teach me, and open me to the reality of who you are. Give me an understanding of you that is coherent, convincing, and that leads to the life you promise. Amen.

*Prayer of Belief.* Lord Jesus Christ, I admit that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever dared admit, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dared hope. I thank you for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete forgiveness. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Amen.





- 4. How should Paul's prayer in I:9-II shape the way that we pray for ourselves and others?
- 5. Reflect on this verse from Augustus Toplady's hymn, "A Debtor to Mercy Alone." How does this beautiful truth connect with you today?
